Date: December 1993

Synopsis: Bibliography compiled by the Assistant Librarian of the Royal Armouries.

Richard III and the Princes in the Tower

APPS D. (compiler)

Description: Leaflet

Date of publication: 1983

Synopsis: Selection of non-fiction books and novels then in Buckinghamshire libraries; not annotated.

A Guide to Sources of Information on Richard III and the Development of Ricardian Historiography

BAKER Christine A. (compiler)

Description: 48-page typescript

Date of publication: 1971-2

Synopsis: An annotated bibliography, intended to guide librarians and general readers.

Richard III in the 1980's: An Inprint Bibliography

BENNETT Linda (compiler)

Description: Booklet

Date of publication: 1984

Synopsis: List of books then available, both non-fiction and novels; well annotated.

Richard III in the Department of Manuscripts

BURROWS L. C. (compiler)

Description: 33 pages, mixture of photocopies and fresh type

Date: Undated

Synopsis: List of many of the manuscripts in the British Library relating to Richard III.

The Reign of Henry VII: Some Recent Contributions

CHRIMES S. B.

Description: From *Welsh History Review*, Vol. 10, No. 3

Date of publication: 1981

Synopsis: Reviews of recent books and articles, mainly on legal and administrative aspects of the reign.

A Study in the Historiography of King Richard III

HEATHCOTE K. A.

Description: B.A. thesis, University of Liverpool

Date of presentation: May 1952

Synopsis: Study of historians' changing attitudes; the basis for the later work of A. R. Myers.

Recent Work on Richard III: A Survey

HORROX Rosemary

Description: From *History*, Vol. 72, No. 235

Date of publication: June 1987

Synopsis: Review of articles and books published between 1983 and 1985.

The State of Research: Local and National Politics in Fifteenth-century England

HORROX Rosemary

Description: From *Journal of Medieval History*, Vol. 18, pp. 391-403

Date of publication: 1992

Synopsis: Review, based on a select group of works, of the changing attitudes of historians to the interlocking roles of the king, nobility and gentry in fifteenth-century England.

Wales and Bosworth Field – Selective Historiography?

JONES Emyr Wyn

Description: From *National Library of Wales Journal*, Vol. 21, No. 1

Date of publication: 1979

Synopsis: Discusses the literature on the Battle of Bosworth, and its ignoring of the role of Wales and Welshmen.

Richard III: 1452-1485

LOVE-TAYLOR G.

Description: Islington Libraries booklet

Date of publication: 1974

Synopsis: Selection of books to be found in Islington libraries on Richard III, his times and his associates; well annotated.

Richard III and Historical Tradition

MYERS A. R.

Description: From *History*, Vol. 53, No. 178

Date of publication: June 1968

Synopsis: Investigates the attitudes of historians to Richard III, from the sixteenth to the twentieth century.

Richard III: His Life in Fact and Fiction

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY LIBRARY

Description: Pamphlet

Date of publication: Undated, but circa 1976

Synopsis: "A selected list of Books in the stock of the North Yorkshire County Library." Lists twenty-one novels (13 with annotation) and twelve non-fiction books (seven with annotation).

Richard III

Description: Pamphlet

Date of publication: June 1984

Synopsis: A selected list of non-fiction and novels on Richard, with some annotations, compiled to mark Scarborough's Richard III Quincentenary celebrations.

After McFarlane

RICHMOND Colin

Description: From *History*, Vol. 68, No. 222

Date of publication: February 1983

Synopsis: Article reviewing ten books published on late- fifteenth-century history between 1979 and 1982, including biographies of Henry VI, the Duke of Clarence and Richard III.

Reading History: Tudor Kingship

STARKEY David

Description: From *History Today*, Vol. 32

Date of publication: June 1982

Synopsis: Discusses biographies of the kings of England from Henry IV to Henry VII.

Richard the Third of England: A French Historiography

VALE Lawrence J.

Description: Typescript, 29 pages

Date: 20th May 1977

Synopsis: Describes the work of French writers on Richard III from the fifteenth to the twentieth century.
