Synopsis: Bibliography compiled by the Assistant Librarian of the Royal Armouries.

Description: Leaflet

Date of publication: 1983

Synopsis: Catalogue of selected non-fiction books and novels held by Buckinghamshire libraries; not annotated.

England's Official Rose: Tudor Concepts of the Middle Ages

ATTREED Lorraine C.

Description: From *Hermeneutics and Medieval Culture*, ed. P. J. Gallacher and H. Damico

Date of publication: 1989

Subjects covered: Henry VII, Tudor historians

Synopsis: On Henry Tudor's view of himself as successor to the early British kings, bringing peace and order after the instability of the previous reigns, and on Tudor historians' views of the past.

Description: 48-page typescript

Date of publication: 1971-2

Synopsis: An annotated bibliography, intended to guide librarians and general readers.

Date of publication: 1984

Synopsis: List of books then available, both non-fiction and novels; well annotated.

Date: Undated

Synopsis: List of many of the manuscripts in the British Library relating to Richard III.

Description: From *Welsh History Review*, Vol. 10, No. 3

Date of publication: 1981

Synopsis: Reviews of recent books and articles, mainly on legal and administrative aspects of the reign.

A Study in the Historiography of King Richard III

HEATHCOTE K. A.

Description: B.A. thesis, University of Liverpool

Date of presentation: May 1952

Synopsis: Study of historians' changing attitudes; the basis for the later work of A. R. Myers.

Recent Work on Richard III: A Survey

HORROX Rosemary

Description: From *History*, Vol. 72, No. 235

Date of publication: June 1987

Synopsis: Review of articles and books published between 1983 and 1985.

The State of Research: Local and National Politics in Fifteenth-century England

HORROX Rosemary

Description: From *Journal of Medieval History*, Vol. 18, pp. 391-403

Date of publication: 1992

Synopsis: Review, based on a select group of works, of the changing attitudes of historians to the interlocking roles of the king, nobility and gentry in fifteenth-century England.

Date of publication: 1979

Synopsis: Discusses the literature on the Battle of Bosworth, and its ignoring of the role of Wales and Welshmen.

Date of publication: 1974

Synopsis: Selection of books to be found in Islington libraries on Richard III, his times and his associates; well annotated.

Date of publication: 2011

MYERS A. R.

Description: From *History*, Vol. 53, No. 178

Date of publication: June 1968

Synopsis: Investigates the attitudes of historians to Richard III from the sixteenth onwards.

Description: Pamphlet

Date of publication: Undated, but circa 1976

Synopsis: 'A selected list of Books in the stock of the North Yorkshire County Library.' Lists 21 novels (13 with annotation) and 12 non-fiction books (7 with annotation).

Description: Pamphlet

Date of publication: June 1984

Synopsis: A selected list of non-fiction and novels on Richard, with some annotations, compiled to mark Scarborough's Richard III Quincentenary celebrations.

Date of publication: 2011

Synopsis: On the sources and composition of Fabyan's chronicles.

Description: From *History*, Vol. 68, No. 222

Date of publication: February 1983

Synopsis: Article reviewing ten books published on late- fifteenth-century history between 1979 and 1982, including biographies of Henry VI, the Duke of Clarence and Richard III.

STARKEY David

Description: From *History Today*, Vol. 32

Date of publication: June 1982

Synopsis: Discusses biographies of the kings of England from Henry IV to Henry VII.
